JEREMY

DILLON

JEREMY

Start →

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DILLON

For the same reason why she doesn't want me to help with the wedding... she's a control freak.

JEREMY

What a terrible thing to say about your bride.

DILLON

She knows she's a control freak and she knows I know she's a control freak. But I know her inside and out, she has her limits. I'll give her one more day and she'll be begging everyone for help. That's how it usually goes.

JEREMY

Really, you think so?

DILLON

Yes, and when she has that moment, you'll be the first person I suggest help her.

JEREMY

Thank you, Dillon. I hope you're right. It's killing me watching her coordinate her colors with her themes and not even asking me for an opinion.

(pause)

Is there is anything I could do for you?

DILLON

You know how to tie a real bow tie?

Jeremy rushes to help Dillon.

JEREMY

Of course I do. I have Mr. Biggles wear one every New Years eve.

DILLON

Mr. Biggles?

JEREMY

Yes, he'll be wearing one for the wedding, too.
